



KAMKUMUNG CHURCH SECURED WITH NEW PERIMETER FENCE THROUGH AIL-FUNDED COMMUNITY PROJECT

The Gaius Memorial Lutheran Church in Kamkumung Village has received a significant upgrade with the construction of a new perimeter fence, funded by Ahi Investment Limited (AIL) through Ahi Charitable Trust. The project is valued at P_{gk} 49,653.83 and delivered in alignment with Sustainable Development Goal 11 (SDG 11): Sustainable Cities and Communities, which promotes safe, resilient, and inclusive community infrastructure.

The fencing project was carried out from 10 to 20 February 2026, resulting in the installation of a 2.4-metre-high secure boundary fence surrounding the church grounds. Ahi Prudential Development Limited (APDL) thru Ahi Hope Foundation (AHF) contracted Humbille Limited to deliver the works, which were completed within schedule and met all project specifications.

The new fence now offers enhanced security for church building, equipment, and community assets, while also strengthening boundary control.

Church leaders reported that the enclosure has reduced unauthorised access and improved the general orderliness of the grounds. They also highlighted that the improved appearance of the fenced grounds enhances the dignity of the worship space and provides a more controlled environment for both church services and community activities.

Church representatives expressed appreciation to AHF, AIL, and APDL for supporting the project, describing it as a timely and much-needed investment that benefits both the congregation and the wider community.
